As we seek to fulfill the Great Commission, Message Ministries will sponsor a Youth Camp this summer for teens living in low and middle income areas of Peru. While Youth Camps are no longer any "big deal" for American kids, in places like Peru a Youth Camp can still be a highlight and turning point in a young person's life. Many of these Peruvian kids come from homes with no indoor plumbing or electricity. Some don't even have their own bed to sleep in and have to share a bed with siblings.

For such children, the facilities and living quarters at the camps are luxurious (even though we Americans would describe the lodgings as "dingy"). Anticipation lights up the faces of these Peruvian youths as they arrive at and enter the campgrounds and dormitories. In a country where hunger and malnutrition are the status quo, these kids will stampede into the cafeteria when word spreads that a meal is being served. Mealtimes mean that every bone is scraped clean of meat and every bowl is licked clean of soup, and it doesn't matter if the meal isn't "perfect" by American standards. These kids are always deeply grateful that God has provided so much food and nourishment, even if camp only lasts for a few days. Here in the U.S., we would probably turn down food and lodging like this; it would fail to meet our high material standards and would receive a polite "No, thanks" from most of us.

Worship time at these camps simply explodes with fervor, gratitude, and celebration. At last year's camp, the young people danced for more than an hour almost every night in celebration before the Lord. The loud moments were joy-filled, and the quiet moments instilled awe and solemnity. During one of the quieter, serene moments last year, as I was praying for a Peruvian friend, I looked up and saw an amazing scene. One hundred and fifty people – everyone in the room, both natives and missionaries, were crying, praying, and worshiping on their knees in total devotion to the Lord. Some prayed

over others and many were in tears as the campers expressed the purest Godly love for one another. It was one of the most beautiful, memorable moments of my life.

I've experienced many such moments at our Peruvian Youth Camps. We have sponsored the camps annually for six years now, working to show these great young people the light and heart of Christ and encouraging them to walk closer to Him. What's amazing is that these kids are as great a blessing to us, and shine as much light on us as we shine on them. We look forward to more awesome times at this year's upcoming Youth Camp.
